

WAYS TO GIVE TO THE CHANDLER CENTENNIAL CAMPAIGN

1. Cash, Check, Credit Card, Automatic Payments:

A gift made by cash or check is an immediate way for you to contribute to the Centennial Campaign. Or you may wish to make a contribution using a credit card, for a one-time gift or for multiple payments over a period of no more than three years. You may also arrange for automatic payments from a savings or checking account.

2. Pledges, Payments over Time: A multi-year pledge is a convenient way to spread your Centennial Campaign contribution over no more than three years. The flexibility of a longer payment schedule allows you to take a tax deduction each year you make a gift, and to make a more substantial contribution than you might consider in a single year.

3. Appreciated Stock: A gift of appreciated stock (i.e., the stock's fair market value is higher than your cost basis) is an excellent way for you to make a substantial gift to the Centennial Campaign. You are entitled to take a tax deduction for the fair market value of the appreciated stock, and avoid paying capital gains tax. Please notify Chandler of any stock gift, since donor names are not included in the transfer process between brokers.

4. Appreciated Real Estate: You may own some real estate, possibly a second home or a parcel of land, which you would like to use as a gift to the Centennial Campaign — assuming that the property has appreciated since you purchased it, your gift would be valued at fair market value by a professional appraiser. If you would like to make a gift of real estate to Chandler, please contact us before you sell the property. You may be able to realize some tax advantages.

5. Other Appreciated Personal Property: You may own an original oil painting, an antique restored vehicle, or another valuable piece of property that you would like to give to the Centennial Campaign. That gift would need to be valued at fair market value by a professional appraiser.

6. Other Ways to Give: There are many other ways to give to Chandler's Centennial Campaign, such as donating the income from a partnership or half ownership of a piece of property. Your financial adviser is the best source of information on these.
