Chandler invites you to consider one of the naming opportunities listed below, just a sampling of those available. This could be a way for you to memorialize a family member, recognize a beloved mentor, or publicize an inspirational saying.

An elegant, simple wooden plaque, produced locally from local woods, will be placed on the named space once your gift has been received or your pledge fully paid. In the meantime, the opportunity will be “held” for you as the donor.

- ☆ \$750,000 for the new addition, with the name prominently displayed
- ☆ \$500,000 for stabilization of the existing back wall so that the addition may be constructed, with the name prominently displayed
- ☆ \$500,000 for a gentle update of the Music Hall, without tampering with its excellent acoustics
- ☆ \$500,000 for the fully renovated and technically re-equipped Main Stage of the Music Hall building, including raising the roof over the stage so that theatrical flies and modern lighting may be safely hung
- ☆ \$200,000 for the Main Gallery, on the first level of the Gallery building, a beautiful exhibit space with natural light
- ☆ \$200,000 for the Upper Gallery, on the second level of the Gallery building, a spacious room for events and workshops
- ☆ \$150,000 for the Music Hall lobby, with its warm woodwork, to be opened to the Gallery to facilitate the flow of people
- ☆ 150,000 for state-of-the-art lighting and sound equipment for the newly renovated Main Stage
- ☆ \$120,000 for the Costume Room on the second level of the addition, a space where the collection can be properly stored and easily accessed
- ☆ \$120,000 for the Workshop in the addition, behind and connected to the Main Stage, for set construction and student tech training
- ☆ \$100,000 for furnishings and fixtures for the new building and for the renovated spaces in the existing building
- ☆ \$100,000 for resurfacing the Main Stage in a more acoustic-friendly wood surface and constructing an easily installed temporary floor for such uses as summer youth musicals

- ☆ \$80,000 for the Lower Gallery, an exhibit space to be created opposite new restrooms in the lower level of the Gallery
- ☆ \$80,000 for the large Community Kitchen on the 2<sup>nd</sup> level of the Gallery, a room designed for flexible uses
- ☆ \$80,000 for the Gallery Lobby, renovated into a gracious entryway to both the Gallery and Music Hall spaces
  
- ☆ \$60,000 for the Multi-Purpose Community Room on the 2<sup>nd</sup> level of the addition, for rehearsals, sewing classes, etc.
- ☆ \$60,000 for the Administrative Suite on the 1<sup>st</sup> level of the Gallery building, offices for the staff
- ☆ \$60,000 for the “facelift” of Chandler’s front plaza, with a new electronic marquee and Gallery display box, dramatic and efficient lighting for the front and side entrances, and attractive landscaping
  
- ☆ \$40,000 for the Community Studio in the lower level of the Gallery, designed to house art classes
- ☆ \$40,000 for the Gallery Annex on the 1<sup>st</sup> level of the addition, serving the Gallery building but also available as a meeting space
- ☆ \$25,000 and \$20,000 respectively for the two Lesson/Practice Rooms on the second level of the addition, soundproof spaces to serve musicians and musical groups
  
- ☆ \$15,000 for the climate-controlled storage room to preserve and protect the Steinway grand piano
- ☆ \$15,000 for the storage space for the sound shells essential for choral and chamber performances
- ☆ \$10,000 for body microphones compatible with the new sound equipment, especially key for youth performances
- ☆ \$10,000 for re-veneering 35 badly-deteriorated historic seats in the Music Hall (2 naming opportunities)
- ☆ \$10,000 for a permanent supply of seat cushions, free for patron use in the Music Hall
